

# SACRAMENTO COUNTY FAIR FACT SHEET

The Sacramento County Fair takes place during Memorial Day Weekend and typically draws over 100,000 attendees. The Sacramento County Fair serves its community through its many youth programs; for over seventy years the Fair has provided a platform for local 4-H and FFA youth to show and sell livestock, demonstrate club projects, and display arts and crafts. More recently, the Fair has opened its doors to Sacramento area elementary schools with its popular FREE School Tour Program, hosting over 12,000 local students each year.

The Fair is fun, affordable and safe for the whole family! The community enjoys the traditional Fair competitions, agriculture displays, technological competitions, thrill rides, festival-style entertainment, hands-on family activities and specialty foods.

No income tax dollars are received by the Fair. Only 35% of the operating expense budget comes from a tax on horse race betting; the remaining balance of 65% is produced locally. Community and Corporate support keeps the Sacramento County Fair open and affordable for all!
