# DID YOU KNOW the correlation of Sacrifice and Salt???

The Bible from beginning to end is about the **sacrifice** of the Lamb of God, Jesus Christ our Savior. There is a little about salt. Did you know

### SACRIFICE???

<sup>24</sup>For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us: <sup>25</sup>Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others; <sup>26</sup>For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the <u>sacrifice of himself</u>. (Hebrews 9:24-26)

But this man, after he had offered one <u>sacrifice for sins for ever</u>, sat down on the right hand of God; (Hebrews 10:12)

Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ <u>our passover</u> is <u>sacrificed</u> for us: (1 Corinthians 5:7)

## THE LAMB OF GOD???

He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a <u>lamb to the</u> <u>slaughter</u>, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth. (Isaiah 53:7)

### JESUS WILLINGLY GAVE HIS LIFE FOR US!!!

<sup>18</sup>Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; <sup>19</sup>But with the <u>precious blood of</u> <u>Christ</u>, <u>as of a lamb</u> without blemish and without spot: (| Peter |:|8-|9)

The next day John seeth <u>Jesus</u> coming unto him, and saith, Behold the <u>Lamb of God</u>, which taketh away the sin of the world. (John 1:29)

And looking upon <u>Jesus</u> as he walked, he saith, Behold the <u>Lamb of God!</u> (John 1:36)

#### SALT???

All the heave offerings of the holy things, which the children of Israel offer unto the LORD, have I given thee, and thy sons and thy daughters with thee, by a statute for ever: it is a <u>covenant of salt</u> for ever before the LORD unto thee and to thy seed with thee (Numbers 18:19)

<sup>23</sup>When thou hast made an end of cleansing it, thou shalt offer a young bullock without blemish, and a ram out of the flock without blemish. <sup>24</sup>And thou shalt offer them before the LORD, and the priests shall <u>cast salt upon them</u>, and they shall offer them up for a burnt offering unto the LORD. (Ezekiel 43:23-24)

And every oblation of thy meat offering shalt thou season with salt; neither shalt thou suffer the salt of the covenant of thy God to be lacking from thy meat offering: with all thine offerings thou shalt offer salt. (Leviticus 2:13)

### SALT AND FIRE???

For every one shall be **salted with fire**, and every sacrifice **shall be salted with salt**. (Mark 9:49)

I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the <u>Holy Ghost, and with fire:</u> (Matthew 3:11)

Salt is good: but if the salt have lost his saltness, wherewith will ye season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have peace one with another. (Mark 9:50)

Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men. (Matthew 5:13)

Jesus came to earth and lived a perfect sinless life, to be that sacrificial lamb, to pay for the sins of all who will receive his gift of Salvation is complete in Jesus. Jesus is the perfect sacrifice and he said "we are the salt of the earth". By the power of the Holy Spirit, our salt will have savior; and we can glorify God in our life. We are to go and tell the gospel to the world.
