

### Four Reasons FBC in 2019 Will Knock Your Socks Off — We can and should expect that this is going to be an amazing year of growth!

A year ago, we launched our focus "A Place of Grace" here at First Baptist Church... pledging to let go of old grievances, speak in ways that build each other up rather than tearing down, elevating the positive rather than the negative.

Many people have remarked that they sense **our church is a completely new place** because you were so faithful to that "Place of Grace" commitment. A breath of sweet, fresh air has blown through our church, the joy and peace of the Spirit of God, and it has been a wonderful year.

Now, as we start 2019, I really believe that we are in for one of the most exciting years in our church's history! *Here's why...* 

1. Mission Growth! We increased our missions giving in the last two budgets. Now it's time to increase our missions *activity*. We are forming a partnership with a mission church in Pennsylvania that you'll be hearing more about. We plan to take teams—both students and adults—on trips to assist this church in reaching the lost in their community. As we go, we will grow as believers and leaders, but we will also learn more about how to reach those right here in our community.

2. Growing Hunger for God! The chaos and disruption in the world around us just seems to keep increasing. The people around us who don't know our Savior live in that same world, but without the hope and peace that comes from knowing the Mighty God, the Solid Rock. People are searching!

The problem? They don't know that what they are searching for is found in Christ and among His people! It's our job to go next door with God's life-changing love.

**3. Children's Ministry!** We will be working to expand and grow our children's ministry this year. It has been true for a long time that reaching children reaches whole families. It used to be that parents dragged children to church. But today, it's often children who are dragging parents to church. And we want to support their efforts!

We are years behind in renovating our Children's Wing, so that has to



be a priority. And we will need to provide the funding and *especially* the volunteers needed to provide excellent, exciting, effective ministry to children and their families.

**4. Outreach Focus!** I will be pushing every group, every ministry to look at their work with an outreach focus. We need to ask, "How do we do this in a way that connects with people who need Jesus?"

That means doing student ministry with a heart for the students who don't know Jesus. That means doing Senior Adult ministry with an intentional approach toward those seniors who are outside of the church. That means the pastor's sermons have to be clear and relevant to the person who doesn't know Jesus as Lord.

Are you ready for an exciting, lifechanging year of following Christ at First Baptist Church?





Last Fall, we began a journey through the Gospel of Mark, focusing on the stories of Jesus' encounters with people in need... all kinds of needs. And we began seeing how, in every case, their need was met perfectly in Jesus.
