- Note 1- Safety and Timers will be called to the line in advance of the competing teams for every event.
- Note 2 - If there are not a minimum of 3 Revolver Teams, the Revolver Match will be canceled and Individual Matches will proceed.
- Note 3 –This is a **2 minute rapid fire** event to put as many hits into each paper plate on a card board backer in 120 seconds. Scoring will be based on Table 28.1 (b) of the N-SSA Skirmish Rules.
- Note 4 -The 3-inch disc is required to be struck before any bottles are broken. A penalty of 50 seconds will be added on the teams' score for each bottle hit prior to the 3 inch disc being hit. Normal penalties will be also be applied for remaining bottles.
- Note 5 - Skirmishers must register for Aggregate Awards upon initial registration to be eligible. Fees are due during the skirmish. Make checks payable to: 20th Georgia V. I. Regiment. Individual Skirmish Awards will be announced between Carbine Relays and Team Events between Musket Match relays. Protest time for Individual Matches concludes at 3 pm on Saturday.
- Note 6 - Smooth side of brown tile will face shooter.

## **Accommodations**

**Sunrise: 6:46 AM      Sunset: 7:02 PM**

**Brierfield Ironworks Park** has numerous campsites for RV and tent camping. Some have full hook-ups, some do not. There is a central bath house. The park also has cabins available for rent. Camping arrangements and fees must be handled through the park.

## **Range**

The range firing line and ready area are covered and can accommodate up to 6 or 7 teams firing at one time. The ready area has 6 large tables. There are restrooms at the shooting range. A medical bag and CO2 bottle for clearing arms are maintained at the base of tower.

## **Food**

The host team will be operating a concession stand on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. On Friday only cold drinks, water, and coffee available. Breakfast and Lunch will be available on Saturday. Breakfast will be available on Sunday.
