Mission Co-op Weekend

St. Luke N.E.W. Life Center Mission Appeal

We have the privilege of coming to Resurrection of the Lord Parish on July 21st & 22nd to speak to you about the St. Luke N.E.W. Life Center in Flint. We are a local mission. Our work is centered in Flint's north end. We provide groceries and hot meals to some 3,000 individuals each month. Through this part of our mission we are living the works of mercy to feed the hungry and give clothing and a listening ear to those who are desperate and hopeless. At the Center we also provide Employment preparation in a sixteen week program of skill building and formation. We attend to the educational needs of our people by offering the opportunity to attain GED status. Once a woman or man graduates from our program of employment preparation, we hire them for 60 days to make sure they have a work ethic before we send them on to partner employers.

We also have two social enterprise businesses: commercial sewing and lawn care. We are about to launch a hoop house to provide healthy vegetables year around for our people to counteract the lead in their bodies from the water and a bakery so we can sell bread and decorated cakes.

Sr. Judy and Sr. Carol will be at your parish to speak at all of the Masses. We will also bring some of our graduates so you can hear from them firsthand about their experiences at the St. Luke N.E.W. Life Center.

We are looking forward to being with you on July 21 & 22. Sr. Carol and Sr. Judy.
