Your cooperation is greatly needed and appreciated in helping us produce our 15th annual recital. There are certain requirements all parents and students must meet in order to ensure a successful show. **Please read this notice in its entirety** and save it to aid in the preparation of the recital.

Tickets: Tickets for the recital go on sale Saturday, May 11 at 10AM. It is very important you know which show you need to order tickets for. Tickets are non-refundable. Remember that all students in the 7 and older classes are in BOTH shows. The Saturday 6 yr old and under classes are in the 11am show only. The Weekday 6 yr old and under classes are in the 4pm show only. We strongly suggest the 6 yr old and under classes purchase their tickets as soon as they go on sale as they are only in 1 show and you want to make sure you have tickets for that show. Tickets must be purchased on-line by going to our website. There will be a link on the home page soon. Tickets will be sold on a first come first served basis. The cost is \$19.00 per ticket. There is no minimum or maximum number of tickets you can buy. We ask that you please purchase tickets as soon as possible as we need to give the Police and Fire Department a count of how many guests will be at the show. Students appearing in the show will not need a ticket as they will be backstage and not allowed into the auditorium. If a parent is staying backstage with their child the whole time they will not need a ticket. Each person watching the show will need a ticket. **No one will be allowed into the auditorium without a ticket.** Young children may **not** sit on parents laps. This is a fire law. Infants not capable of sitting in their own seat should not attend the show. Parents changing students must stay backstage the entire show. They will not be allowed in and out of the auditorium. **The doors will remain closed during the entire act.** This will ensure a smooth running show and guests watching the show will not be distracted from parents walking in and out of the auditorium. Remember we are putting on a professional like show. **Please inform guests to arrive early to find parking and find their seats. If guests arrive late, they will only be allowed into the auditorium in between numbers and will have to sit in the back of the auditorium so guests watching the show are not interrupted.**

Pictures: Picture Day is scheduled for Saturday, May 18. Donner Photographic will be taking our pictures again this year. They have specialized in dance photography for over 40 years. All classes will take a group photo and then individuals will be taken. We ask that all students attend picture day, even if you do not wish to purchase photos. We would like to have a keepsake of all the students in the class to display at the studio. **Please remember all costume alterations must be completed by Picture Day. Correct tights and shoes are needed for Pictures as well.** Students should arrive with make-up and hair already done. Assigned times are listed in the back of this notice. Donner Photographic will be at the studio on **Tuesday, May 28 from 4:30-8:00pm** with printed pictures that you can take home with you that day. Absolutely no photography will be allowed at the recital. **Please note that all regularly scheduled classes on Saturday, May 18 are cancelled.**

Make-up: We will be having an instructional class on how to apply the make up for pictures and recital on Sat, May 11th at 1:00PM. We will also have one on Wed, May 15th at 7:00PM. We will also e-mail instructions with pictures as well.

Recital T-Shirts: T-shirts will be distributed the first week in June. If you did not order one, we may have a few extras. Please check with the office about sizes available.

Chaperones: We are looking for 2 parents from each class to chaperone and monitor their child's class at the Studio Rehearsal, Dress Rehearsal and Recital. If you are planning on staying with your child backstage, we could use your help as a chaperone. Chaperones should be over 18 and will be responsible for the safety and conduct of their class. They will also make sure students are backstage 3 numbers before they are to perform, help keep children entertained while they are waiting in the dressing room, and to make sure everyone has the correct costume on, correct shoes and head pieces secure. If you would like to volunteer, there is a sign up sheet on the bulletin board by the office.

Recital Program Ad Space: Once again we are offering advertising space in our recital program. This is a great way to promote your business or show support for your children. More information is in the back of this newsletter.

Studio Rehearsal: The week of June 3rd we will not be holding regular classes. Students will have a studio rehearsal and dress rehearsal. The first studio rehearsal will be held at the studio on **Monday, June 3 for all 6 and under classes from 5:00pm to 6:15pm.** The second studio rehearsal will be held at the studio on **Tuesday, June 4 for all 7 & older classes from 5:00pm to 7:00pm.** **Please come dressed in regular dance attire. This rehearsal is mandatory for participation in the recital.** Only excused absences allowed. After each rehearsal we will have a small pizza party and present 5 & 10 Year Plaques.

Dress Rehearsal at Methuen High School Auditorium: **All outstanding balances must be paid in full to participate in the dress rehearsal and recital.** Students should arrive at Methuen High School auditorium on **Wednesday, June 5, at 4:30PM to check in.** Each recital order is a little different. We will run the rehearsal as close to the show order as possible. Please make sure students are dressed and ready to go for each number they are in. We will not be stopping the run through. It is important that students be aware of how much time they have to change if they are in multiple numbers. We do not want any student to miss their number. The dress rehearsal will be over by 7:30PM. When dancers are not changing or performing, they are welcome to watch the dress rehearsal. Students should be backstage at least three numbers before they are to perform. **Each student is only allowed to bring one parent/guardian.** This will help the rehearsal run as smooth as possible. Any student bringing more than one parent/guardian will be charged a \$20 observation fee per person. **Siblings and other family members not in the show will not be allowed into the auditorium without paying the \$20 observation fee.** At the dress rehearsal you may videotape your child dancing if you wish. **No videotaping will be allowed during recital.** You may also take as many photographs as you wish, provided you are not using a flash camera. The flash is very distracting to students on stage and is a safety issue. **No photography of any kind will be allowed during recital.** Please inform guests of this rule. Anyone using electronic equipment during the show will be asked to leave by security. Please be considerate to the students performing. **This rehearsal is mandatory for participation in the recital.** Only excused absences allowed. Please make note of the following information:

- Students should arrive by **4:30PM. Rehearsal is in FULL COSTUME & MAKE UP.**
- Hair should be worn as instructed. Please slick back bangs, as they cover the eyes and create shadows.
- Please do not wear any jewelry or nail polish.
- Please do not wear any underclothes other than tights or nude camisoles for female students.
- Each class (younger students) will have at least one monitor. Upon arrival please check in with your monitor.
- Do not leave your area without informing your monitor. If you are in more than one dance, sit with your first group you dance with. After your 1st dance, tell your monitor you are going to join your next group.
- You should be backstage three full numbers before your dance is to begin. We realize some students have quick changes. We ask that you join your group as soon as possible.
- Please change costumes as quickly as possible. We will not stop the run through of the show because someone is missing. Be aware we will not stop the recital either if someone is missing.
- After performing, please return to your group so that the backstage coordinators can find you to line up for the finale.

- NO EATING OR DRINKING IN THE AUDITORIUM!!! This is the policy of the Performing Arts Center. Anyone who is seen consuming food or beverages in the auditorium will be asked to leave. Students should never eat or drink while in costume.

Recital: Our recitals will be held on **Saturday, June 8. The first show is at 11am. Students should arrive by 10am. The second show is at 4pm. Students should arrive by 3pm. Please go directly to changing areas.** No Guests will be allowed in changing areas or backstage. Please make note of the following information.

- All students must stay backstage, in their dressing rooms during the entire performance. **No students will be permitted into the auditorium.**
- Young students may come fully dressed with make-up.
- Please wear a robe, jacket, or T-shirt over your costume when you arrive. We don't want to let the audience see our costumes before we perform. Also we want to keep them nice and clean.
- Hair should be worn as instructed. Please slick back bangs, as they cover the eyes and create shadows.
- Please do not wear any jewelry or nail polish.
- Please do not wear any underclothes other than tights or nude camisoles for female students.
- Each class (younger students) will be supervised with at least one monitor.
- Please bring a book or something small to take up the idle time before and after your numbers.
- After performing, please return to your group so that the backstage coordinators can find you to line up for the finale.
- Smile and have fun!! This is your opportunity to show the audience how hard you have worked all year and how much you love to dance!!

Video: The recital will be professionally videotaped by Gary Antle Productions. Order forms are available in the back of this Newsletter and on the website.

Cameras: No photography or video cameras of any kind will be allowed into the auditorium. Please be aware of this rule and inform all guests coming to the recital.

Recital Orders: You will find the show orders in the back of this Newsletter. Each student should have a minimum of 3 numbers to change from one routine to the next. Please check that your child has at least 3 routines to change for all of the routines they are in. If they do not, please inform the office immediately.

Classes after recital: Please note our season ends June 22. Students will have 2 weeks of classes after recitals. During these classes, students will watch a video of their routines from the recital. We will also have bring a friend week and work on technique and skills to prep for next season.

Summer Camps: Summer camps are the week of August 5-9th. We are now accepting registrations! The flyers are posted on the website. We recommend registering early to guarantee your child a spot in the camp.

2019-20 Schedule: Fall classes start Tuesday, September 3. We are now accepting registrations! The schedule is posted on the website. Once again, we recommend registering early so we can monitor class sizes better and guarantee your child a spot in the desired classes. Many of our classes filled and had waiting lists the past 2 years.
