

CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATION

About the Course

The curriculum consists of four training weeks designed to teach the basic skills needed to conduct crime scene investigation.

Each training week is pre-scheduled at intervals resulting in one training week per month.

Requirements for completion include participation in all four training weeks, successfully passing testing and proficiency assessments, and demonstration of skills during real world work assignments.

The training staff consists of a core group of practicing CSI's who have been Instructor certified by the NJ Police Training Commission, and have previously attended the Course.

Guest instructors from New Jersey and New York law enforcement and forensic agencies will provide instruction in various topics as subject matter experts.
