# Recipe of the Month from 2000 Scrape Book

### (presented by Bonnie Theard)

#### **Cobbler Delight by Madeline Willoughby**

*Ingredients:* 

1 cup butter

2 cups sugar

3/4 cup shifted flour

1 cup whole milk

1 teaspoon vanilla

2 cups fruit (your choice)

#### Directions:

Soak Fruit in one cup of sugar. Melt butter in baking pan to be used and pour excess into second cup of sugar and mix. Alternately mix in flour and milk (to sugar). Add vanilla and mix thoroughly. Fold in fruit that has been soaked in sugar. Bake at 350 degrees until starts to brown (golden color). Do not over bake. Cool and top with Cool Whip. Storages in refrigerator very well.
