Introduction to Forensic Psychological Interviewing

24 Hours

Scope: This course is designed to assist students, police officers, first responders, detectives and attorneys. After the completion of this interviewing component, students will:

1. Be able to articulate the key skills required for a range of interview types.
2. Be more confident in their ability to apply these key skills to a variety of interviewing contexts.
3. Be more aware of areas that they need to further develop when communicating in everyday situations.

This class is useful for students, police officers, detectives and attorneys.

Day 1:

- a. 5 hour lecture: Interviewing bases and structure, formulating objectives and relevant questions, stages of the interview.
- b. 3 hour student to student supervised practice.

Day 2:

- a. 8 hour lecture: Learning how to questioning, reviewing the responses and communication skills.

Day 3:

- a. 4 hours lecture: Vocabulary and Rapport, non-verbal cues, empathy and active listening, Reflecting, Paraphrasing, Clarifying, Summarizing, active listening.
- b. 4 hour practical student to student in class supervised interviewing.
