Introduction to Forensic Psychological Interviewing

24 Hours

\$399/person

Scope: This course is designed to assist students, police officers, first responders, detectives and attorneys. After the completion of this interviewing component, students will:

- 1. Be able to articulate the key skills required for a range of interview types.
- 2. Be more confident in their ability to apply these key skills to a variety of interviewing contexts.
- 3. Be more aware of areas that they need to further develop when communicating in everyday situations.

This class is useful for students, police officers, detectives and attorneys.

Day 1:

- a. 5 hour lecture: Interviewing bases and structure, formulating objectives and relevant questions, stages of the interview.
- b. 3 hour student to student supervised practice.

Day 2:

a. 8 hour lecture: Learning how to questioning, reviewing the responses and communication skills.

Day 3:

- a. 4 hours lecture: Vocabulary and Rapport, non-verbal cues, empathy and active listening, Reflecting, Paraphrasing, Clarifying, Summarizing, active listening.
- b. 4 hour practical student to student in class supervised interviewing.
