Welcome to Fall!

In this Trustees Corner, we would like to advise the Aerie of a change coming January 1. Beginning that day, the Aerie will implement a dual pricing structure in the bar and restaurant. All items will have two prices; a credit card price, which includes a 3% increase and a cash price, which remains the same as current prices. This means if you pay with cash, you will receive a 3% cash discount. This change is intended to help cover the approximately \$1,000 a month the Aerie spends on credit card fees. These funds could be better used for charitable contributions or club improvements. If you have any questions, please contact Trustee Robert Hanlon for specific questions on this topic or leave your contact information in the suggestion box.

Starting in November when playing the Shake-a-Day game, if you roll a 4 of a kind you will receive one free roll. If you roll a 5 of a kind on your free roll you win the pot.
