February 25, 2018 Second Sunday of Lent Mark 9:2-10

"Peter said, 'Rabbi, it is good that we are here! Let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah"

Jesus, with Peter, James and John, made the strenuous climb to the top of Mount Tabor, a craggy, cone shaped mountain. To the southwest across the lush Jezreel Valley is Meggido, where Revelation prophecies Armageddon, the final battle between good and evil. To the north are Nazareth where Mary consented to be the Mother of the Messiah; and Cana, where Mary tells the servants to "Do whatever he tells you." In this context Jesus appears totally different, standing with Moses the "Great Lawgiver" and Elijah, the "Great Prophet. He reveals his mission as Messiah and the consequences he will suffer. Peter, filled with amazement and confusion, proposes to stay in the safety and comfort on top of the mountain. Jesus leads them off of the mountain to help him fulfill his mission. We may never visit the top of Mount Tabor, but Jesus challenges us to step out of our comfort zone and help him fulfill his mission. Lent is a time to recall and reflect on the life and mission of Jesus, and to choose to follow and imitate him.
