Peter Guster, 80, of Caseville, died Tuesday, February 8, 2005, at Huron Medical Care Facility in Bad Axe of pneumonia. Peter was born February 13, 1924 in Chicago to the late Joseph and Elizabeth (Steinbach) Guster. He grew up in Caseville. He then entered the U.S. Navy during World War II serving in the South Pacific. After the war, he returned to Caseville and married Elaine Bolzman on August 20, 1949 in Bach.
