



DRIVER EDUCATION INFORMATION

Driver Education Classes are offered to students through JDS of the Carolinas throughout the school year and summer. General information is provided below.

Requirements:

- Must be at least 14 ½ years old to participate
- Complete 30 hours of classroom time
- Complete 6 hours of behind the wheel instruction.
- Must pass final exam given on last day of class

Location: Franklinton High School Campus

Dates: Refer to Registration Form

Times: After school from 3-6pm
You must provide your own transportation.

Fee: \$65.00 Cash or Check made payable to FHS

Additional Information:

Each student will be given an eye exam by a DMV representative one day during that time. They must pass the eye exam in order to drive in the car.

You may want to send a snack for your child as they will be taking a break.

If you do not attend the first day, you will be dropped from the class and a substitute will take your place. All days require your attendance.

When choosing your dates, please be aware of athletic, band, or extra-curricular activities that may conflict.

Students should be academically in good standing in order to take the class. There may be a delay in obtaining your permit or license.
