Seventh Amendment to the Delta Pilots Disability and Survivorship Plan (as amended and restated effective July 1, 1996)

The Delta Pilots Disability and Survivorship Plan, as amended and restated effective July 1, 1996 (the "Plan"), was amended effective June 1, 2006, to implement the provisions of Section Q (including Attachment 26-2) of Letter of Agreement #51 (LOA 51) between the Company and the Air Line Pilots Association (ALPA) that provided for changes to the Plan. Among those provisions, was Section Q(d) which provided for an offset of Social Security disability benefits from Long Term Disability benefits (LTD benefits) paid from the Plan. Subsequent to June 1, 2006, the provisions of LOA 51 were incorporated into the PWA and the provision requiring offset of Social Security disability benefits from LTD benefits was incorporated in Section 26 K.4 of the PWA. Effective June 1, 2006, Letter of Agreement #17 removed the offset of Social Security disability benefits from LTD benefits, *ab initio*. Therefore, the Plan is amended as follows:

- Social Security Disability benefits of the disabled pilot will not be offset against his Long Term Disability benefits under the Plan paid before, on or after June 1, 2006.
- 2. Except as expressly amended herein, the Plan shall remain otherwise without change.
