

ORDINANCE NO. 9-22-15

CITY OF JACKSON, ALABAMA
AN ORDINANCE APPROVING
AMENDED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
FOR ECONOMIC AND INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the promotion of economic and industrial development in Clarke County, Alabama, and the municipalities therein is a shared power of the Clarke County and such municipalities; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-102-1 et seq., of the Code of Alabama, 1975, provides for agreements among counties and municipalities for the joint exercise of powers and services of such entities; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Jackson, Alabama, on 9-8-15, a proposed Amended Intergovernmental Agreement for Economic and Industrial Development by and among Clarke County, Alabama, and the municipalities of Coffeetown, Fulton, Grove Hill, Jackson and Thomasville, a copy of which is attached to and made a part of this resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. That the City Council hereby finds that the promotion of economic and industrial development in Clarke County and its municipalities is a shared power of Clarke County and such municipalities.
- Section 2. That the Amended Intergovernmental Agreement for Economic and Industrial Development by and among Clarke County, Alabama, The Town of Coffeetown, Alabama, the Town of Fulton, Alabama, the Town of Grove Hill, Alabama, the City of Jackson, Alabama, and the City of Thomasville, Alabama, for the operation and funding of the Clarke County Economic Development Office, and as presented to this meeting, is hereby approved on behalf of City of Jackson, Alabama.
- Section 3. That the Mayor of the City of Jackson is hereby authorized to execute such agreement on behalf of City of Jackson, subject to proper approval of Clarke County and the other municipalities set forth therein,

and to carry out such further actions as may be necessary to effectuate such agreement.

Section 4. Pursuant to Section 11-102-1 et seq., of the Code of Alabama, 1975, this shall be considered an ordinance of general and permanent operation.
