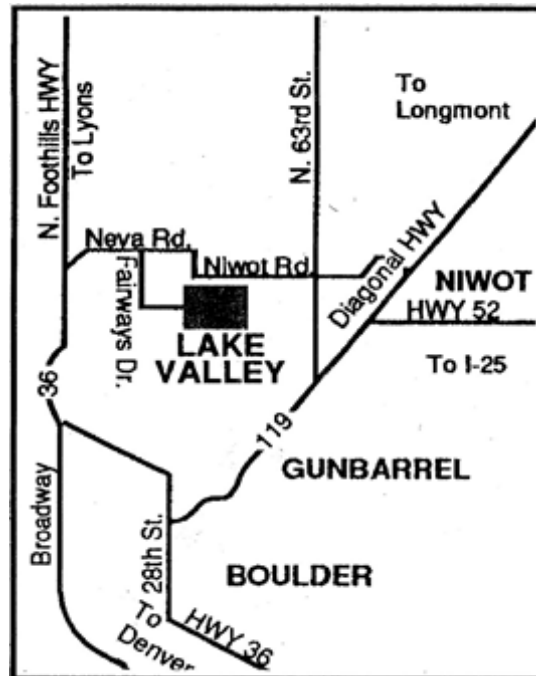


Participate in this fun tournament and show your support for programs which keep our children safe, physically fit, educated, and allows those with silent disabilities to lead more normal lives.

Canine Considerations

For practical reasons and for your dog's safety, the following restrictions apply-

- ❖ *Dogs must not be aggressive to other dogs or people.*
- ❖ *Dogs must be on-leash at all times.*
- ❖ *There can be only one dog per cart (2 dogs per 4-some).*
- ❖ *Golfers are responsible for determining the compatibility of the 2 dogs in their 4-some.*
- ❖ *Each cart w/ a dog must have 2 riders. One to drive and one to tend to the dog.*
- ❖ *Any time the cart is in motion, the dog must be between the riders and fully constrained.*
- ❖ *Dogs will not be allowed on the greens. Tie-up stakes near the greens will be provided.*
- ❖ *Dogs shall not be left unattended in the cart.*
- ❖ *They could cause the brake to be released.*
- ❖ *Dogs shall not be allowed in the rough or in neighboring properties.*
- ❖ *Poop bags will be provided, please clean up after your dog!*
- ❖ *If the club Pro and/or the tournament director deem a dog is hazardous to the safety of humans, other dogs, or property, they may require that dog be withdrawn from further participation. Registration fee will be refunded in full.*
