Orchestral Master Class Competition Information

Competition Description:

The Orchestral Master Class Competition is open to all flutists. Two or three winners will be selected to play for our guest artist, Emily DePalma, principal flutist of the Louisiana Philharmonic Orchestra. The master class will be open to all registered festival attendees. *Applicants will be judged based on accuracy of rhythm, intonation, and technique and overall interpretation and musicianship.* Winners of the Orchestral Master Class Competition will prepare the recorded excerpts for the master class IN ADDITION to excerpts assigned by the guest clinician prior to the festival.

Competition Requirements (recordings must be emailed and registration forms & payment must be postmarked by 5:00 pm March 1, 2019):

Record THREE orchestral excerpts of your choice. No accompaniment is required.

- The recording must be **unedited**, however, excerpts/different movements may be recorded on different tracks. *Edited recordings will be disqualified.*
- Do not speak or make any identifying sound on your recording.

To Submit Your Recording:

1) Email your recording in MP3 format to louisianaflutecompetition@gmail.com no later than 5:00 pm on March 1, 2019.

- In the subject line of your email, enter LFS 2019 ORCHESTRAL MASTER CLASS COMPETITION.
- In your email, include your name as you prefer it to be listed in the program.
- List your repertoire selection(s) in the order they are recorded.

*To be eligible for the Orchestral Master Class Competition, you are required to be a member of the Louisiana Flute Society. Registration for the festival will pay annual membership dues. Materials submitted after March 1 and/or without payment will not be considered.

3) Please make checks payable to **Louisiana Flute Society**; only one check is necessary for registration and competition entries. We cannot accept credit card payment at this time.
