### Reconnection Therapy Information Sheet

Reunification is a usually a court related term for therapy to assist with the introduction or the re-establishment of a relationship between a parent, child, and siblings. The main goal is to provide a safe space for the people involved to express themselves, to use therapist lead techniques to increase communication, and to be able to establish a working relationship. This working relationship can be described as many types. Some families can manage to work through circumstances and re-establish a relationship. Some relationships are built on new identified boundaries set by either the child (ren) or the parents that may eventually strengthen.

Reconnection therapy is a process. It begins with each party meeting with a clinician, individually to begin. This allows for the clinician to assess whether a meeting is appropriate and if joint sessions will be productive. The clinician makes the determination of readiness based on a series of items such as ability to cope with a joint session, emotion management from both parties, and the goals of each party. This part of the process may take as few as three sessions and can be some time before joint sessions are recommended. It is possible one party is more prepared than the other and more work with one party would benefit the entire process.

Both, parents or guardians of the child must attend at least the intake session and sign the appropriate forms. The payments are paid in advance by at least one week and a retainer or credit card are required to keep on file. The fees are based on gross family income of \$96,000 per year. If the gross of such income is less than \$96,000 per year, you qualify. The range for fees are \$125-\$175 per hour.
