Entries Close: Thursday, July 5th. Pre-entry required. NO LATE ENTRIES. NO ENTRIES DAY OF SHOW. Limited space is available.

Arrival time: Friday, July 20th check-in 8:00 AM - 9:30 AM. All entries must be checked in by 9:30 AM

Judging: Friday, July 20th at 1:00 PM in Poultry Barn

Release: All open class birds will be released immediately following conclusion of show. No overnight cooping.

GENERAL RULES:

- Entries are open to all Minnesota residents.
- Each exhibitor will be limited to 2 entries per lot and a total of 15 birds on display. One family may not exhibit more than 30 birds.
- Limited space is available. Entries will be taken on a first come first served basis.
- All poultry except waterfowl, besides being healthy, must meet the Exhibition of Livestock and Poultry in Minnesota State Rules. Go to the following link for more information. www.mn.gov/bah/exhibitions.html
- All poultry, including waterfowl, must have numbered leg or wing bands.
- All chickens and turkeys must be accompanied by a negative test for pullorum – typhoid conducted within 90 days of entry or present proof of origination from a hatchery or breeding flock that is classified pullorum-typhoid clean.
The New American Standard of Perfection will govern the judge in all varieties recognized therein. Excepting egg layer and market pens, any breeds or varieties not recognized by the standard cannot compete for special or champion awards.
- Egg layer and all market pens may be hybrids.
- Entries in poultry class shall consist of single specimens, egg layer pens, market pens, and trio pens.
- Trio Pens shall consist of 1 male and 2 females of the same variety.
- Egg layer pens shall consist of 2 females of the same variety or hybrid.
- Market pens shall consist of 2 males or 2 females of the same variety or hybrid.
- Single entries may not be entered in pens.
- Regular premiums paid on all lots provided there are three or more entries.
- Cock (or old male): Male bird hatched prior to 2018.
- Cockerel (or young male): Male bird hatched in 2018.
- Hen (or young female): Female bird hatched prior to 2018.
- Pullet (or young female): Female bird hatched in 2018.

Class 6 Egg Layer Chicken Pen

Lots in this class egg production potential is emphasized. Judging is based on health, vigor, uniformity of development, and egg production characteristics

- 1 Pen of 2 Young Brown Egg Layers
- 2 Pen of 2 Young White Egg Layers

Class 7 Market Pen of 2 Birds

In this class meat type quality production is emphasized. Judging is based on health, vigor, uniformity of development, degree of finished fleshing, and free from market defects. A market pen must be 2 males or 2 females.
