Mayor Russell Wood, Jr. called to order the Village of Bloomingburg regular Board of Trustees Meeting of July 12, 2018 at 6:00pm in the Village of Bloomingburg Hall, Bloomingburg, N.Y.

The meeting was open with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Regular Meeting

Mayor Wood announces that Yitz Vann has resigned from the ZBA as Chairman. Mayor Wood states that the Village Board has met with a few candidates and they have all decided that they would like to appoint Israel Fleischman as the interim Chairman for the ZBA.

Mayor Wood asked for a motion to appoint Mr. Fleischman to the ZBA as the interim Chairman. Aaron Rabiner made the motion and was seconded by Samuel Weingarten.

Mayor Wood states that the Village board has a been working with the Village Attorney Alex Smith about abolishing the Planning Board and having the ZBA take over all duties of the Planning Board. This will give the ZBA all control over any applications that come before the board. We would like to create a law for this change as well as expand the number of members for the ZBA.

Mayor Wood: Alex can we set a Public Hearing fort his now?

Alex Smith: Yes. It would be for 3 Local Laws. One to abolish the Planning Board and the ZBA take over their duties. The other to expand from 3 members on the ZBA to 5. Also you would need a law to add an additional ZBA alternate.

Mayor Wood: I would like to make a motion to hold a Public Hearing on August 9<sup>th</sup> , 2018 at 6:00pm for these 3 Local Laws. Aaron Rabiner; ill seconded the motion. All in favor: Aye.

Mayor Wood: I have a resolution here to be voted on by the Village Board for a Village credit card. The credit card will only be used by myself, the Village Clerk Blake and or Tonja the Village Treasurer, The credit card will only be for little things the Village needs that we cant get from staples; like light Bulbs and gas for the maintence worker things like that.

Aaron Rabiner: Ill make the motion. Samuel Weingarten Ill seconded the motion. Mayor Wood; all in favor: Aye.

Mayors Report:

Mayor Wood: I don't have too much to say. The Sewer Plant is working well. There are no issues there. The Village is looking good. There isn't garbage all over. The Village Court has been collecting fines and the Building Inspector has been on top of things. The Village Maintenance worker has been on vacation when he returns the sidewalks will continue to get cleaned up. The Dutch Reform Church was saved by the Residents votes.
