## TOURS OF THE MUHLENBERG HOUSES

While in Trappe for the Muhlenberg play, immerse yourself in the town's rich history with guided tours of two Muhlenberg family houses open to the public. Enjoy a visit to the Henry Muhlenberg House, which was recently refurnished from top to bottom with many Muhlenberg family portraits, books, furniture, silver, and other objects. Don't miss the museum's gift shop, where handmade local pottery, books, notecards, and other treasures await. Just five doors away is The Speaker's House, home of Henry's son Frederick Muhlenberg, first Speaker of the U.S. House of Representatives. Here you will learn about the house's ongoing restoration and stroll through the site's authentic Pennsylvania German kitchen garden.

Both houses will be open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on October 27 and 28. Guided tours last about 45 minutes. Admission is \$5/adult per site; discounted rates are available for children. **Due to anticipated demand, timed tickets for house tours will be sold in advance.
