First Lesson Proverbs 3:5-13 **5** Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; **6** In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths. **7** Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the Lord and depart from evil. **8** It will be health to your flesh, And strength to your bones. **9** Honor the Lord with your possessions, And with the firstfruits of all your increase; **10** So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine. **11** My son, do not despise the chastening of the Lord, Nor detest His correction; **12** For whom the Lord loves He corrects, Just as a father the son in whom he delights. **13** Happy is the man who finds wisdom, And the man who gains understanding;

Second Lesson Hebrews 11:1-6 **1** Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. **2** For by it the elders obtained a good testimony. **3** By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible. **4** By faith Abel offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, through which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts; and through it he being dead still speaks. **5** By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, "and was not found, because God had taken him"; for before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God. **6** But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.
