To the Sherburn and Welcome City Councils,

The department logged 145 calls for service for the month of May. This brings the total for the year to 875 calls. The department logged 976 calls in 2016 and 825 calls in 2015 for the same reporting period.

The response time average for the month was 4 minutes. This is a good response time; however, it is slightly above our normal average for the department.

Officer Post left the department at the end of May to take a position with the Martin County Sheriff's Office. Dylan had been with us since 2015 starting as a part-time officer and then moving to full-time in 2016. Dylan did an excellent job and we wish him the best. We have started the process for replacing Officer Post and will hopefully have the spot filled by the end of the summer.

The department registered 2096 visits to the web-site last month. This was the most visits in a month since the site has been operational. With the department in the process of hiring a new officer, this would explain the increased traffic.

The department again conducted the bicycle safety rodeo for area children on June 10. The event was attended by 13 children and a number of prizes were given out thanks to the generous donation we received each year from Truck Writers in Welcome.
