Bailey's 69 Captures Jacobsen Golf Title

Young Al Bailey of Cedar Rapids fired a one-over-par 69 Monday at Indian Creek Country club to capture individual honors in the fifth annual Jacobsen Open golf tournament.

Bailey, a sophomore at State College of Iowa, recorded a four-under-par 30 on the front nine, but he was no exception to the history of bad play on the back nine. In four previous years, no player has managed to break par on the course.

An out-of-bounds shot off the No. 18 tee cost Bailey, as he took a triple-bogey and finished with a 39 for a 69 total. Had he picked up his bogey-five, he could have broken the par-68 layout.

Bailey's card included 10 pars, five birds, a bogey, double-bogey and a triple-bogey.

Two Grinnell golfers — Paul Ahrens and John Allen — tied for second place with 73s. Ahrens shot par going out, but also came in with a 36 on the back side.

Lloyd Koehler of Cedar Rapids won first flight honors with a 78. Other flight winners included Harry Birdsell, Hampton, second with a 78; Larry Pearson, Anamosa, third with 81, and Rich Wall, two-time winner from Cedar Rapids, fourth with 88.
