## Notes from BYSO Parent Meeting, Sunday, September 25, 2016

## Mr. Barry Peters, senior orchestra conductor

- Welcome to all members, both returning and new. BYSO is happy you are here!
- The schedule for rehearsals and concerts, as well as other information, is found on the BYSO website, www.binghamtonyouthsymphony.org.
- There are two regular concerts:
  - Sunday January 15, 3017, 3 p.m. at West Middle School in Binghamton school is located on West Middle Ave which is a one way street that runs from Kneeland Ave to Helen Street (from Riverside Drive, turn north onto Kneeland at Lourdes Hospital, then left on W. Middle; from Main Street, take Beethoven south, then right on Jefferson, left on Kneeland, and quick right on W. Middle)
  - o Sunday May 14, 2017, 3 p.m. at Binghamton High School
- On November 13, 2016 at Binghamton High School, both orchestras will record a holiday concert, which will be broadcast on local television station 8-10 times during the holiday break. The preparatory orchestra will meet first (1-2:30 p.m.) and then the senior orchestra (3-5 p.m.).
- On Tuesday March 7, 2017 the senior orchestra will perform for approximately 2000 area school children in the Introduction to the Orchestra concert at Binghamton University. There are two concerts, one at 9:30 a.m. and the second at 11 a.m. Students will need to miss the entire morning of school. Typically schools have excused these absences.
- Policies
  - Absences students are permitted to have four absences per half year (first half is through the January concert, and second have is through the May concert). Students who miss more than that will be missing a significant portion of the rehearsals and may not be sufficiently prepared with the concert music.

  - O Dress (for all concerts, including holiday recording)
    Senior orchestra: ladies, all black, avoid short dresses (some stages are elevated); men black suit, white shirt, black bow tie, black shoes, black socks, no sneakers.
    Preparatory orchestra: ladies, white top and black bottom (skirt or pants); men, white dress shirt, tie of any color, black pants, black socks, black shoes.
- Seating auditions are for senior orchestra only.
- The Concerto Competition is held each year to select soloists to perform with the orchestra. The competition is open to any member of BYSO, though in the 50+ year history of the competition, only one or two of the chosen soloists have been from the preparatory orchestra.
- Parents are welcome to listen to rehearsals from the hallway because the room is quite full.
