April 23-27 Online Open Registration to the Public

Reminder that Priority Registration for Summer School and Fall will take place the week of March 12<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup>. Priority Registration is for our current students and their siblings for Summer School and Fall Registration. The system that we use for registrations on our website, is currently working on their reregistration format, so we are unable to use the Online Application for Priority Registration this year. So, this year we will do actual paper registrations that will need to be submitted to the school for processing. We will be handing out the instructions, new tuition rate sheets, and registration applications beginning Tuesday, February 20<sup>th</sup>, so please be sure to stop in the office to get yours. Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis, beginning Monday, March 12<sup>th</sup>. Once we have processed your application, you will receive a bill with Registration Fees/ Summer Deposits that are due. As a reminder, your space is not guaranteed until all payments have been received. Open Registration to the Public will be held in April, at which time we will be giving out remaining spaces.

To help with your planning, the dates for the Summer Sessions are:

SUMMER SESSION 1: June 18-July 13 (Closed July 4th)

SUMMER SESSION 2: July 16-August 10

SUMMER SESSION 3: August 13-September 7 (Closed Sept. 3rd for Labor Day and Sept. 4th

for School Maintenance)

FALL SESSION BEGINS: September 10th

Our Easter Party will be on Friday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>, the Pre-Kindergarten (Happy Hippos, Groovy Goldfish, Funky Foxes and Excellent Eagles) will walk to Lomita Park and have their party. The rest of the students will celebrate here at school. The Easter Bunny will be stopping by to visit during the parties. Children who do not normally attend on Fridays may attend as long as accompanied by an adult (Please check the wall by the fish tank for times and more information, or see the office with any questions) Parent helpers will be needed for this busy day. We will be asking for treat donations. If you are interested in bringing in goodies, or volunteering, please check the sign-ups by the fish tank.

Please note that Payment #8 will be due on Monday, March 26th which is during our Spring Break. Although we will be open (for Daycare Only), this is the same timeframe for Spring Break in most of the public schools. So, if you think your child may not attend due to vacation or other time off, make sure to pre-pay, or turn in a postdated check before the due date to ensure that you are still eligible for the discounted rate.

We will be open during Spring Break (Monday, March 26<sup>th</sup> – Thursday, March 29<sup>th</sup>), regular hours, for <u>DAYCARE</u> only. Your child may attend on their regularly scheduled days, however, for staffing purposes, we do ask that you let the office know whether your child will or will not attend, by signing up on the Holiday Survey that will be posted in the foyer near the fish tank during the week of March 5<sup>th</sup>. If you have someone else do the drop off/pick up for you child(ren), you can send the school an email letting us know if you need your child to attend or not. To guarantee that we will have enough staff members on campus, students MUST be signed up in order to attend. The last day to sign up will be Friday, March 9<sup>th</sup>.

## **REMINDERS:**

Please drive slowly as you are entering and exiting the parking lot. We have had a neighbor recently inform us that they were almost hit on the sidewalk while walking their dog.
