DID YOU KNOW ...?

May is the peak month for strawberries! State growers produce and ship a BILLION pounds annually. Our fields yield 10 X more than those in Michigan and 20X more than New York's. California produces more strawberries than any other state or country in the world.

How is that possible? Strawberries, and people, both like the same kind of real estate... warm coastal areas with sunny days and cool nights are ideal. Our berries are hybrids cloned multiple times and even shipped to the northern California and Oregon mountains to chill. When they come home, they burst into production. We ship nationwide from late March to late June.

All strawberries are very susceptible to disease, especially fusarium wilt. Commercial growers go to great chemical lengths to protect their crops. Organic berries are much more expensive because to avoid fumigation the crop can only be grown on the same soil once every 3-5 years. Growers must constantly move the crop over expensive real estate to avoid disease.
