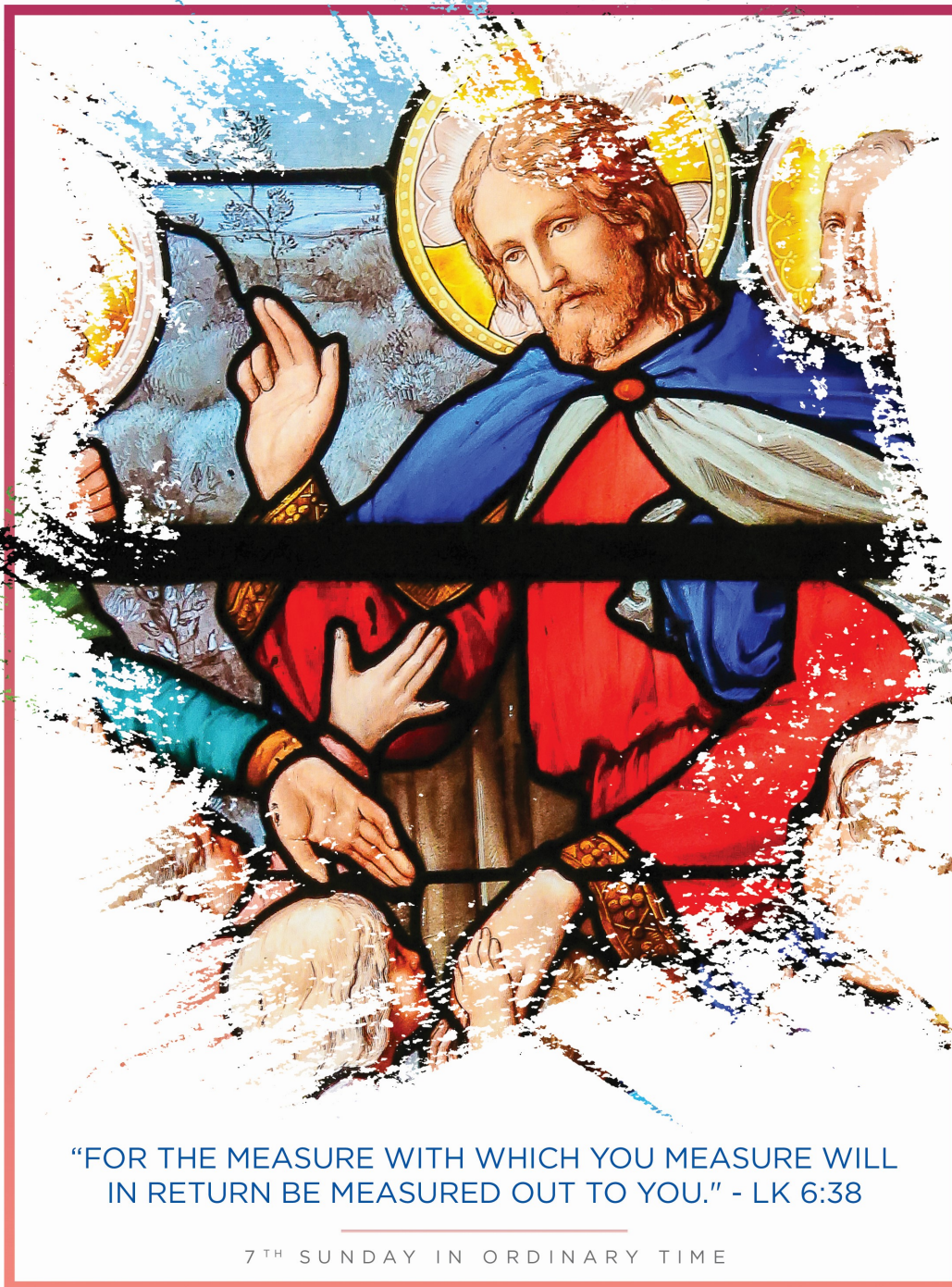

Lent Begins March 2

Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the waters of baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ.

Bury the Alleluia

Have you ever noticed that during Lent we don't say 'Alleluia'? Growing up I remember when one of my siblings or I would say 'Alleluia' during Lent we would snicker and go "oooooo", like we had just said a 'bad word'. But why do we stop

saying this word during Lent?

Alleluia, or Hallelujah, is an expression of praise or rejoicing. Lent, however, is a time of repentance, patience, and even sorry. So 'Alleluia' is the opposite of what the theme of Lent is. During Lent we wait patiently for the Resurrection at Easter, where just as Jesus rose from the dead our shouts of praises and 'Alleluia' also burst forth.

How can we bring this concept to our children? One practice is to bury the Alleluia. You can print off and cut out the letters to spell 'Alleluia', or you could go to the craft store and buy wooden letters you can use over again each year. You can 'bury' them by hiding them. If you use paper letters, put them in a box to 'bury' them. If you use wooden letters that can stand up, cover them with a purple cloth so they are hidden. On Easter morning you can 'dig them up' but taking the letters out of the box or uncovering the letters and once more rejoice in gladness for our Lord is risen!

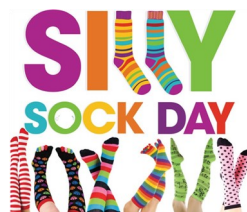
