MIKE RICHARDS

Mike Richards is dedicated to changing the course of America! Through "The Mike Richards Radio Report," a daily commentary addressing critical issues of importance that effect each one of our lives, as well as "The Mike Richards Report Digest," a publication reaching multiple thousands throughout the United States, Mr. Richards is motivating the American public to positive action.

"What began as a strong conviction to inform America of the truth, has developed into a grass-roots army," says Mr. Richards. Born in San Augustine, Texas, Mr. Richards was reared in Port
Arthur, Texas. He graduated from Abilene Christian University
with a degree in Business Administration. His accomplishments
are numerous:

- ... Twice selected (1965 and 1970) as one of "The Outstanding Young Men of America"
- ... Houston's "Salesman of the Year" award (1970)
- ... "The Freedom Award," given to the Houston area leader
 who best exemplifies the principles and ideas upon
 which this nation is founded (1978)
- ... "The Americanism Award," presented by The Junior Chamber of Commerce (1980)
- ... Who's Who in American Politics (1983)

In 1980, Mr. Richards was elected to the State Senate of
Texas. While in this position, he served on the State Affairs
Committee, Senate Education Committee, and the Senate
Administration Committee. Senator Richards was officially
honored by the Texan's War on Drugs Committee for having
co-sponsored Bill # SB 120, the "wire-tap" bill, authorizing
court-ordered electronic surveillance of suspected felony drug
pushers.

In addition to his political and personal accomplishments, Mr. Richards business achievements have proved to be equally successful. In 1973 Mr. Richards became the founding President of what is now The Mike Richards Company, a Financial Services Corporation. In addition, in 1974 Mr. Richards was elected Chairman of the Board at Industrial State Bank, and in 1977 Chairman of Northwest Bank and Trust.

The media outreach of "The Mike Richards Report," is now Mr. Richards primary focus. Originally begun in 1978, the radio commentaries are today currently reaching over 700 radio stations throughout the United States. Together with "The Mike Richards Report Digest." issues of critical importance are being addressed, stimulating conservative/liberal discussion and motivating people to action.

In addition to serving as President and Chairman of Americans
For An Informed Public, which sponsors The Mike Richards
Report, Mr. Richards also serves as a member of the United
States Board of Living Bibles International, a member of the
National Development Board of Abilene Christian University,
plus numerous other civic and public service organizations.

Mr. Richards and his wife Cynthia are the parents of two children and reside in Sugar Land, a suburban community of Houston, Texas.
