#### 3. Kathleen Broman – HR Manager, Benefits

- Open enrollment 5/13 5/31
- Passive if you do nothing, nothing changes
- Employees who waive benefits must do that every year
- There will be cost increases
  - o 2.58% increase
  - The new handbook has more info
- ER copay has increased by \$50
- Out of pocket max is increasing by \$1,000 for both options
- 13% increase for dental
  - DHMO plan is less expensive
  - But has limitations on which dentists you can go to
  - May 21 Dental Lunch and Learn
- Mediflex contributions are increasing
- MD Live copay is \$10 sign up before you get sick
- Any qualifying changes occurring outside of Open Enrollment must be submitted within 30 days of the event
- Wellness website is back up and running

#### 4. Election Results

- This item was placed on the agenda to announce the results
  - A discussion started on the contested Vice President election

- A request was made to the Special Elections Committee to have a run-off. The decision to accommodate this request will be left to the membership. Mary tabled the discussion until the results of that election take place. Voting ends on 5/23.

# 5. OPEB Update

- The options were submitted to Council and these were voted for:
  - Make benefits for part-time regular employees more attainable
    - Annual inflationary adjustments for Group 3 HRA contributions
    - Annual inflationary adjustments to Group 2 Medicare benefits
  - Minimum benefit for Group 2 who leave the city prior to retirement
- The TSA board met with individual Councilmembers prior to the vote to make them aware of our concerns
- They also met with Ken Jones he was instructed to do more investigation

- 2021 for next wage re-opener

- Deferred comp increases
- Indemnification language added to outlining the city's practice of defending employees against third party claims
- Sabbatical updated to allow take second week after 15 years instead of 20
- Retirement cash-out removed language preventing employees under disciplinary action from receiving the benefit.
- Uniform allowance increased to match UAEA.
- Work schedule a reason must be provided when changing work schedules
- Supervisor never gets a meeting when there is an investigation unless extenuating circumstances
- Council working on parental leave
  - Might have to match with council priorities and strategic initiatives
- Is there a way to deal with chronic complainers? Employees who lodge unfounded complaints again supervisors?
  - We're not disciplining for false complaints
