VOLUNTEER CODE OF CONDUCT

All Volunteers are to read and sign the following Code of Conduct. Volunteers under the age of 18 must have this document signed by a parent or guardian. No volunteer will be allowed to participate in any activity, which is subsidized by the Provincial Body until this is signed and returned.

- 1. The volunteer shall adhere to the instructions, rules, curfews, etc., as issued by the coaches. The volunteer shall act as a replacement guardian while at an event, and therefore will treat athletes with respect meanwhile insuring that the rules and procedures are followed.
- 2. Any incidents involving athletes must be reported to coaching staff immediately. Any disciplinary action involving athletes must occur with support/supervision of coaching staff.
- 3. Volunteers shall avoid being alone with an athlete (unless kin) unless given permission from coaching staff and/or parent/guardian.
- 4. The volunteer shall conduct herself/himself as a representative of the Olympic sport of canoeing and kayaking and of YCKC in a manner that is exemplary. The volunteer shall at all times show and demonstrate respect for peers, competitors, officials, and spectators.
- 5. The volunteer shall not consume or be in possession of alcohol, illegal drugs, or any form of contraband while participating in any YCKC or provincially sponsored activity.
- 6. Failure to abide by the above code may result in removal from duty and/or loss of membership to the club (without reimbursement of expenses).
- 7. The volunteer has proven (ie. a criminal record check) that he/she may legally chaperone children, handle club money, sensitive information, and/or transport athletes and equipment.
