Trail Maintenance

Maintain the Fork Mountain Trail in Monongahela National Forest. Work will involve digging a drainage ditch in the mud, and clipping and trimming vegetation away from the trail.

When: November 11, 2017.

Take your choice of 2 meeting locations:

- 1) 9 AM In front of Fayette County Courthouse in Fayetteville. We will carpool together from there to Gauley Ranger Station, and then on to work site.
- 2) 10:15 AM In front of Gauley Ranger Station, 932 North Fork Cherry Road, Richwood (on 39 just north of town of Richwood). Group from Fayetteville will meet with you here, then everyone will carpool together to work site.

What to Bring: Bring lunch and water (no food or water provided). Also, please bring any hand tools that might be useful, such as shovels, hand trimmers/clippers, loppers, Pulaski/mattocks, hand saws, etc. Training and supervision will be provided by NRGTA staff.

What to Wear: Work gloves, long pants and good footwear (boots/shoes) that can get muddy. Dress for the weather and wear layers for your work.

Who to Bring: Due to the nature of the work, we kindly ask that anyone under 18 be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
