- I. H \_\_\_\_\_

- II. G \_\_\_\_\_  
Jesus used this term in the 3<sup>rd</sup> beatitude "blessed are the gentle." One of the fruits of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22). Meekness is power under control.
- VI. P \_\_\_\_\_  
Long-tempered or longsuffering - endures negative circumstances and never gives in to them.
- VII. L \_\_\_\_\_  
Bearing with one another in love. This kind of love could only be on the agape kind of love that gives continuously and unconditionally.
- VIII. U \_\_\_\_\_  
It is already a fact that we are united with each other; one body many members. All have been baptized by the Spirit into the body of Christ.
