#### The Lord Will Provide

#### **Genesis 22:14**

And Abraham called the name of the place, <u>The-Lord-Will-Provide</u>; As it is said to this day, "In the Mount of the Lord it shall be provided.

If I were going to try to state the theme of the Bible in one phrase it would be, "the Lord will provide." This statement was first uttered by Abraham as he was going up mount Moriah to offer his son Isaac as a sacrifice to God. When Abraham was at the last moment before he sacrificed his son, he was stopped by the angel of God, and there in the thicket behind him was a ram caught by his horns. God did indeed supply exactly what Abraham needed exactly when he needed it. Throughout the Bible time and time again God restates this promise to us, He will provide.

#### Matthew 6:33

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

In the sermon on the mount Jesus again tells us that God will supply our needs if we will seek first His kingdom and His righteousness. What is required of us when it comes to this promise from God is our trust that He will do what He says.

#### **Psalm 27:14**

Wait on the LORD; Be of good courage, And He shall strengthen your heart; Wait, I say, on the LORD!

Generally speaking, when we want something or need something, we would like to have it now. God did not provide the ram for a sacrifice to Abraham until the very last moment. God gave the children of Israel manna on a daily basis for over forty years up until they entered the land of Canaan. He gave them exactly what they needed to get them exactly where they needed to be. Please realize that sometimes today what we need from God may not be given to us immediately. We may have to wait patiently with trust in our Lord that He will truly provide what we need. However, know this, that God will provide exactly what you need if you will trust Him and keep His kingdom and His righteousness as the top priority in your life.

#### John 1:29

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

Not only will God provide our physical needs, but He has and will provide our spiritual needs. It is God who provided the lamb of God, Jesus, to take away the sins of the world. Just as God provided for the children of Israel what they needed to get them to the promised land. He will provide everything we need spiritually to get us to the promised land of Heaven. What is needed from our end is trust, trust enough in God to follow and obey Him by faith.
