MINUTES OF HBPOA COAST GUARD BUILDING November 1, 2018 @ 7:00 PM

The monthly meeting of the Hernando Beach Property Owners Association began at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance. Kathleen Frase, President then called the meeting to order.

Meeting began with motions to accept the October Minutes as published in the Beachcomber and Cal Holland the motion and Betty McGuire seconded it.

Margo McConnell was then asked to give the Treasurer's report and began with acknowledging the donation of \$200 from Chuck Henderson for the Triangle. We also collected \$410 for sale of calendars and still have half to be sold. Margo stated our bank balance is now \$20,273.00.

Carolyn Manno then came to the front and went through the Board of Elections. She went through each position President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary and Director. From the phone calls only 2 people volunteered which was

at the last minute and that was Bud Frase and Joy Martinez. Gladys Moore did nominate Bud Frase for Treasurer but he had already volunteered for the position and accepted. Joy Martinez had also volunteered via a phone call and accepted one of the Director positions and Kelly Reeve had nominated Fran Baird for the other Director position and Fran accepted. Carolyn Manno then closed all nominations.

So for 2019 our Board will be Kathleen Frase as President, Benny Martinez as Vice President, Pat Cordova as Secretary (and all 3 of these people had another term in their position so just agreed to sign off). Bud Frase as Treasurer and our Directors will be Toby Wightman and Joe Wachs who have another year on their term and new Directors Joy Martinez and Fran Baird. Installation of all officers will take place at the January meeting.

Reports:

Before reports were given from each committee, Kathy Frase spoke on shortage of volunteers for all committees and that for the last several years
