<u>PRECEPTS OF THE CHURCH</u> The Precepts of the Church describe the minimum effort we must make in prayer and in living a moral life. All Catholics are called to move beyond the minimum by growing in love of God and love of neighbor.

The Precepts are as follows:

- 1. Attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation,
- 2. Confession of serious sins at least once a year,
- 3. Reception of Holy Communion at least once a year during the Easter season,
- 4. Observance of the days of fast and abstinence, and
- **5.** Providing for the needs of the church.
