Martin J. Wolfram, age 97 of Pigeon, passed away Friday, November 15 at Scheurer Hospital Long Term Care Unit, Pigeon.

He was born in Winsor Township on August 20, 1899, son of the late Albert and Matilda (Jaster) Wolfram. On February 11, 1929 he was united in marriage to Florence Irwin in Detroit. She preceded him in death on March 15, 1986.

Mr. Wolfram was a retired employee of the City of Detroit, working for the commuter bus service and for the Detroit Race Course. Upon his retirement, he moved to Pigeon.

He was a member of St. Francis Borgia Catholic Church, Pigeon.
