It's FINALLY time to get the gang back together...

We are excited to kick off our 2017 season in style – with a new track! Yes – we've raced at this location before, but the property is MASSIVE and the possibilities are limitless! Each year we've added in some new trail here and there, but this time around we have moved the majority of the big bike course to a different part of the property. The start/finish/scoring stuff is the same location as usual, but that's about all that's the "same". We haven't ridden it yet – been too busy cutting it – but a good guess is that there is 8-10 miles of *NEVER RIDDEN TRAIL* waiting for you!!!!

No hammered – hacked up – beat in – old trail...it's ALL FRESH!

We've got some super sweet ups & downs, cool ravines and creek beds, a couple logging roads, and heaps of single-track. After we get a total mileage count, we will figure out what configuration to use for each of the big bike races, but count on them all being different and all having their own helping of freshness.

The 65/85/Ladies tracks will utilize some of the same sweet trails that we have used in the past. Those courses are mostly single track with some field sections linking them together. To keep it exciting and just a little bit challenging, there will be an uphill/downhill or two. The 85/Ladies course will have an extra section to stretch out the mileage.

The 50 track is very rider friendly and mostly separate from all other courses – only sharing the beginning and end of the loop(s). The course is virtually all flat and the least rocky of anything on the property.

Panther Creek is typical of most Missouri tracks, meaning it's fairly rocky and gravelly and it can handle moisture. In fact, much of the course is "better when wet".

Concessions will be available throughout the weekend. There's also an ALL YOU CAN EAT FISH FRY Saturday at 6:30pm in the dining hall. Sometime over the weekend, please be sure to let Dave & Theresa (our awesome landowners) know how much we appreciate being able to come do what we love on their property!

For first-timers to MORE, please take a minute to read through our Rules, and look over our Classes/Numbering lists. Every series does things a little differently than others, so it's important that prior to race day that you are informed. One thing to note is that riders are required to display the appropriate number and background color on all three number plates during our events. If you don't have the correct setup, generics are available at signup for \$3/set of three.

Please make sure that your pets are on a leash at ALL times and remain at your vehicle.

Keep in mind that there is VERY limited cell service at this location. That's okay though – all the cool kids that you'd want to talk to will be there anyway!!! Come join us for all the EPIC-NESS!!!

Directions: From Tuscumbia, head South on Hwy 17 for about 5 miles to State Rd A. Turn left on A and go 4 miles. Turn left on Humphrey Creek Rd (gravel) and then go 1 mile. Race entrance is on the left.
