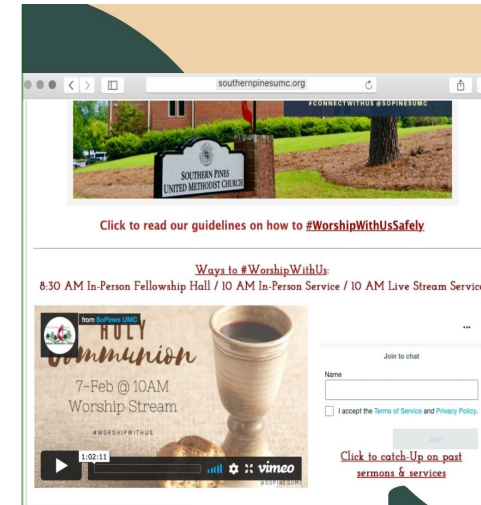
Bill Flinchum. Bill entered life triumphant Monday, February 8.

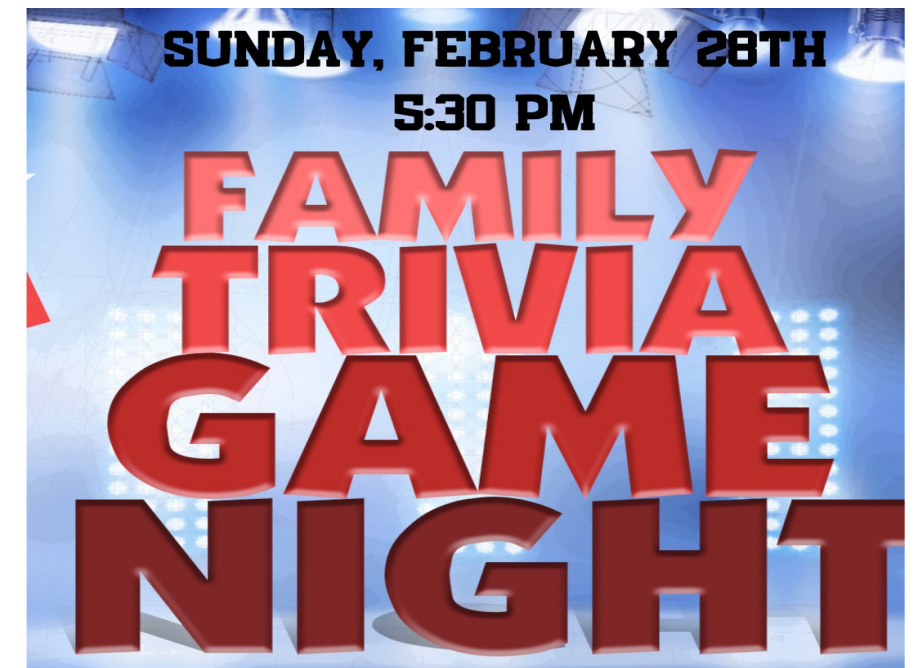
