

March 2019 Plant of the Month

Verbena Gooddingii or called Glandularia Gooddingii is a show stopper for spring!! Native to the southwest especially popular in Arizona, it's a hardy and beautiful low growing plant, perfect for the border of beds or to fill in bare areas under trees.

Hardy to 0 degrees for zones 8–11. Prefers full sun to light shade. Well–draining soil with adequate water. Blooms profusely March – June but can have short sporadic blooms throughout the year. Semi perennial and can reseed if area is moist. Attracts butterflies to its sweetly scented blooms of pink to lavender. Plant in mass for great ground cover or mixed with other striking flowers such as Penstemon, Guara, or Dalea Capitata.
