This should be my last hodge podge article for you. In six years, I have made it to twenty. The following are reminders and things to take note of as we begin our public Masses:

- We begin with public Masses on Memorial Day May 25. There will be one Mass that day at Sacred Heart at 8:30 a.m. for people to fill the pews and it will be live streamed for people to watch at home as well. Honoring those that gave their lives for our country is a wonderful act.
- Family members may sit side by side or fill up an entire pew, but for non-family members there should be no more than four people to a pew to ensure proper social distancing. Ushers will help guide people and let people know when a pew is considered full and when the church is considered full.
- A new Vigil Mass for the weekend will begin on Saturday May 30 at 7 p.m. at St. Joseph parish. This Mass will continue as long as there is a legitimate need and I am able to do it. **For the Sunday 7 a.m. Mass at St. Joseph, the church doors will be open by 6 a.m.**
- Daily Holy Hours will start up once again this week. Check inside the bulletin for the times of the Holy Hours. Thursday and Saturday confession times also resume again this week.
- I celebrate my eleventh anniversary of Priesthood Ordination on May 30. Thanks Lord!
- Please be aware that our RCIA candidates will come into full communion in the Catholic Church at the Sunday St. Joseph 10:30 a.m. Pentecost Mass on May 31. Please also keep them in your prayers for a wonderful future.
- The Tuesday June 2 Mass (6:30 p.m.) for the 8th Grade Graduates of Sacred Heart and the Thursday June 4 Mass (6:30 p.m.) for the 8th Grade Graduates of St. Joseph **should only be attended by the family and friends of the Graduates.**
- We will split up our 13 First Communion kids for Sacred Heart the second weekend of June. The Saturday Vigil Mass at 4:30 p.m. on June 6 will be a First Communion Mass for half of them. Then the other half will have a First Communion Mass on Sunday June 7 at the 8:30 a.m. Mass. **These Masses should only be attended by family and friends of the First Communicants**
- The First Communion Mass for 4 St. Joseph kids will be on Sunday June 14 (Corpus Christi) at the 10:30 a.m. Mass. **This Mass should only be attended by the family and friends of the First Communicants.**
- I will be giving a financial update for the parishes and the schools the week-end of June 20-21.

There will be a special mass to celebrate our Parish Feast Day, the Sacred Heart of Jesus, on **Friday, June 19th. at 6:30 p.m.** Immediately after Mass, we will continue the celebration (with appropriate social distancing) and a free ice cream sponsored by the Altar & Rosary Society. The Feast of the Most Sacred Heart (properly the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus) falls 19 days after Pentecost, on a Friday.
