- 7. The committee suggests to update the Bylaws suggesting to change the verbiage from an audit, (public view), to a financial review to be conducted every 2 years. Majority vote passed among members.
- 8. Discussed homes in our neighborhood that are being foreclosed on. Liens have been established, and we will not relinquish our right to capture the funds past due.
