NOTICE TO DEBTORS REGARDING E-MAIL NOTIFICATION

If you are a debtor in a bankruptcy case (the person who filed bankruptcy is the debtor) and have an internet e-mail address you can receive an electronic notice by e-mail whenever a filing is made in your case. If supported by your e-mail program and if you have Adobe Acrobat Reader installed, you may be able to view the document filed through a hyperlink in the e-mail notice. One look at the document is free, any further openings of the document will require a PACER account which may be obtained at the following web site, <http://pacer.psc.uscourts.gov>.
