

In our practice, we are proud that Dr. Salz performs the vital pre-operative measurements himself and answers your questions at the time of consultation. Dr. Salz trained at the prestigious Wills Eye Hospital in Philadelphia, consistently rated among the top 3 eye specialty hospitals in the United States as ranked by U.S. News and World Report. He was the first ophthalmologist to perform Laser Vision Correction in our area when approved by the FDA in late 1995 and has been performing LASIK since 1998.

Technology is key in the 21st century. Dr. Salz was the first surgeon in central New Jersey to be certified in performing All-Laser Bladeless Intralase LASIK in early 2005. He utilizes the most current generation VISX CustomVue technology which has been shown to reduce the chance of night vision disturbances following laser vision correction.

So what is the "inside" story?? Who might know the difference in skill among the many laser surgeons in New Jersey? Would it be someone who worked intimately in the laser suite as the chief technician and head surgical assistant? Who would that person select to perform laser vision correction for a loved one? Recently, Jon Cesaro asked Dr. Salz to perform CustomVue all-laser bladeless IntraLase LASIK for his wife, Lucia. Jon is the chief technician for New Jersey Eye Laser Center, which runs a series of laser vision facilities throughout northern and central New Jersey.
