### CROWE OVERPOWERS FIELD FOR FIRST GISBT WIN SHOTMAKER COUREY RETURNS TO WINNER'S CIRCLE FOR TITLE # 4

### **CROWE CLAIMS FIRST CAREER GISBT CHAMPIONSHIP**

Cameron Crowe is the GISBT's newest champion. This past weekend, the 2-hander from Orland Park, Illinois, overpowered the field to take home his first GISBT crown. Hosted at Highland Park Bowl in Moline, Illinois, Crowe snatched the lead early in his qualifying round, and continued to pad that lead throughout his 8-game qualifying block by averaging 237.25, which enabled him to roll into the finals with a 158-pin lead. There, he continued to roll the strikes in bunches by averaging 229.12 for his 8 games, and posting a tournament best 6-2 match play ledger. This enabled him to pull away from the field, winning by 228 pins.

Crowe was appearing in just his 3rd career tour event. He had already qualified for the match play finals in his very first showing, with that resulting in a runner-up finish at last October's event in Cedar Rapids. This time out, he was even sharper, and it resulted in a GISBT title.

The champion, who owns one of the most powerful strike balls in bowling, averaged 233.18 for his 16 games. He took home the championship plaque, a \$325 scholarship, and a permanent place on Champion's Row. Congratulations, Cameron!

### **WOLF RUNNER-UP FOR 2nd STRAIGHT WEEKEND**

Avery Wolf completed an exceptional 8-day run. For the second straight weekend, the smooth stroking southpaw from Skokie, Illinois finished as the tournament runner-up. A week ago, that runner-up finish came in Muscatine, and this time out, he achieved his high finish in Moline, Illinois.

For Wolf, he has now racked up 5 match play finals appearances so far in his GISBT career, and this time out, the runner-up showing netted him a \$200 payday. The back-to-back runner-up finishes have enabled Wolf to vault into 2nd place in this season's Bowler of the Year race.

### KOWALIK FINISHES 3rd IN MATCH PLAY DEBUT

Adam Kowalik completed the triumvirate of southpaws at the top of the standings by placing 3rd. The Homer Glen, Illinois resident was qualifying for the first match play finals of his promising career, and he won a \$175 scholarship for his performance.

### 3-TIME TOUR CHAMP SIKKEMA STAKES 4th

Seth Sikkema was this month's 4th place finisher. The right-hander from Fulton, Illinois was the only past champion in this month's boy's finals field. Sikkema, appearing in the 13th match play finals of his career, snuck into the finals on the number, which came at -36, and then worked his way into 4th place during match play. Sikkema, a 3-time tour winner, earned \$150.

### JONES IN FINALS AGAIN, TAKES 5th

William Jones continues his solid rookie campaign on tour. This month, the smooth-rolling righty from Anoka, Minnesota finished in 5th place, earning a \$150 scholarship. Jones has now qualified for the match play finals in 4 of the 5 events he's competed in this season.

### **ROTH DEBUTS IN MATCH PLAY, FINISHES 6th**

Corey Roth enjoyed a breakthrough performance on the GISBT scene at this month's tour stop. The 2-hander from Coralville, Iowa qualified for the first match play finals of his career, and it resulted in a 6th place finish. He took home a \$130 payday for his efforts.

### **MINER TAKES 7th**

In the 9th match play finals appearance of his GSIBT career, Jayson Miner took 7th. The Silvis, Illinois native netted a \$110 paycheck for his performance.

### KRAMER ROUNDS OUT FINALS FIELD, PLACES 8th

Lucas Kramer rounded out the boy's finals field by finishing 8th. Kramer was one of a quartet of 2-handers in this month's finals, and was making his first match play appearance on tour. The Marshalltown, lowa resident earned a \$100 scholarship for his performance.

Jacob Miner took home this month's high game out of the money. The right-hander from Silvis, Illinois rolled a 256 in his final qualifying game to earn the \$55 scholarship.

### **COUREY CLAIMS TOUR WIN # 4**

### **COUREY OVERCOMES DEMANDING CONDITIONS TO POST VICTORY # 4**

Cassidy Courey rolled into the GISBT Winner's Circle for the 4th time in her standout career at this month's tour stop. The talented stroker from Brooklyn Center, Minnesota outlasted a quartet of contenders to take home the top prize. Courey grabbed the lead midway through match play, and maintained a slim lead heading into the position round, where her 201 was good enough to earn the win.

Courey qualified just 2 pins behind the tournament leader, and during match play, she posted the best 6-game total, and a 4-2 match play record was the winning combination this time around. Contested on one of the most challenging lane patterns in GISBT history, Courey averaged 194.28 for her 14 games, and that was enough to hold off a trio of contenders to snare the title.

She took home the winner's plaque and a \$275 scholarship. Congratulations, Cassidy!

### **WILLIAMS IN CAREER FORM, SNAGS RUNNER-UP SHOWING**

Jenna Williams, a powerful right-hander from Homasossa, Florida, was this month's runner-up finisher. Appearing in her 2nd consecutive match play finals, Williams used her big sweeping hook ball to earn a \$200 scholarship. But it almost wasn't to be.

In her very first practice shot, Williams clanged one off her ankle, sending her into limp mode, and an uncertainty of her playing status. However, she shrugged off the pain and took care of business. Williams is one of the young rising stars on tour, and in just 3 tour appearances this season, she has moved into 10th on this season's girl's points list.

### **2-TIME CHAMP DUVER PLACES 3rd**

Hanna Duver, a 2-time tour winner from Indianola, Iowa finished in 3rd place. Appearing in the 32nd match play finals of her illustrious career, Duver rolled into contention during the finals before settling for 3rd. The right-hander found herself just 45 pins out of the lead heading into the decisive position round, but lost a 201-194 battle to the eventual champ, and dropped into 3rd place. She earned a \$150 scholarship for her work.

### **QUALIFYING LEADER SWANK SNARES 4th**

4-time GISBT champion Christin Swank led this month's qualifying at -61 – another demonstration on how challenging the conditions were. She was in contention throughout the match play finals, but eventually settled for 4th place, and the accompanying \$125 scholarship. The Muscatine, Iowa native was appearing in the 20th match play finals of her tour career.

#### **NELSON NETS 5th**

Addy Nelson was this month's 5th place finisher. The right-hander from Gregory, South Dakota hauled in a \$110 scholarship for her finish. Nelson has now appeared in all 6 match play finals this season.

### **FANGMAN 6th IN MATCH PLAY DEBUT**

Abbey Fangman completed this month's girl's finals. The right-handed stroker from Waterloo, lowa was making her match play debut at this month's event, finishing in 6th place, earning a \$100 scholarship for her day's work.

There was a tie for this month's high game out of the money, with that score demonstrating the demanding lane pattern at this month's event. Just 223 was good enough to earn a share of that scholarship. A pair of 2-time tour champions – Megan Hess, of Urbandale, Iowa, and Sydney Urben, from Dorr, Michigan – each earned a \$55 award.
