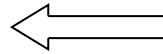

- Adopt-a-Road: Keeping two city streets clear of trash (every other month)
- Arbor Day: Planting a commemorative tree or shrub at Live Oak Park in memory of deceased members.
- Arts in the Park: Hosting a booth at the annual children's festival.
- Birthday Raffle: Members bring a garden-related gift to the general meeting in the month of his/her birthday as a raffle prize
- Flower Show: A juried biennial show featuring horticultural exhibits grown by club members as well as non-members.
- Garden Tour: A biennial fundraiser featuring several local, private gardens in the Fallbrook/Bonsall area.
- Green Thumb Table: Plants, cuttings, seeds and other garden-related items donated by members sold at general meetings.
- Live Oak Park Gardens: Volunteers help in the native plant garden at the local county park.
- Memorial Day Flowers: Members contribute flowers and arrange bouquets for distribution at a local cemetery on Memorial Day. The bouquets are available to the public to be placed on individual graves.
- Penny Pines: Collection of pocket change at the General Meetings for restoration work in Cleveland National Forest
- Scholarships: Club fundraising projects support scholarships for college enrollees pursuing a degree in horticultural or agricultural related fields of study.
- Tours/Study Groups/Workshops: Offer an opportunity for more extensive study of horticulture, floral design and/or crafts.
