SUBJECT: Intelligence Summary Packet (U)

1 (U) This packet contains an intelligence summary on the enemy units operating in our area of operation. It contains their last known location strength and possible missions. It also contains general comments of the status of the enemy units and what to possibly expect during this construction season.

2 (U) A list of incidents, to include minings, booby traps, ambushes, sniping, and incoming rockets, is also included. These are incidents reported by units of the 39th Engr Bn only and can give you a general idea of trouble areas along the secondary roads. Incidents are plotted on an overlay to assist you.

I. ENEMY UNITS OPERATING IN OUR AO.

1 (C) Chu Lai:

a. 409d Sapper Bn: This Bn is a main force engineer unit and is located at DT 3606. It is estimated the unit has a strength of approximately 210 men. Its current target or task is a sapper attack on Chu Lai assisted by the 70th Rocket Bn.

b. 70th Rocket Bn: This Bn is a main force unit and is located at DT 3901. Its estimated strength is 150 men.

2 (C) Route 533.

a. 74th Heavy Weapons Bn: This is a local force unit and is located at DT 1510. Its estimated strength is 250 men. Its main task is to provide fire support for another attack on Tuy Ky city by 72d LF Bn.

b. 72d LF Bn: This is a local force infantry Bn and is located at DT 1019. Its estimated strength is 130 men and its main task is to attack Tam Ky city.

c. D-11 Infantry Bn: This unit is located at DT 2507 and has an estimated strength of 250-300 men. Elements of D-11 have targets in the vicinity of Tien Phouc and is expected to be assisted by the C-7 LF Company.

d. C-7 LF Co: This unit is an infantry unit with a strength of 50 men. C-7 will assist D-11 in attacks around Tien Phouc.

f. Of these other units the 408th MP Sapper Bn presents the most threat. Its strength is indicated to be Hawk Hill and the unit is very mobile.

## 3. (C) Unit 596

a. 107th MM Heavy Weapons Bn: Most of this unit is located at DS 5266 and has a total strength of 300 men. The 1st Co/1 7th BN is located at DS 4674 and has an estimated strength of 75 men. Its mission is to rocket Quang Ngai city and provide support for C-21 LF Co and the 506A LF Sapper Co.

b. C-21st LF Co: This unit is an Infantry unit with a strength of 60 men. It is located at DS 5667 and is expected to make attacks on the training center at Quang Ngai.

c. 506A LF Sapper Co: This unit is an engineer unit with a strength of 50 men. It is located at DS 5097 and it also is expected to attack the training center at Quang Ngai.

## 4. (C) Units 521 to 525.

a. 521st Sapper Co: This engineer company has a strength of 40 men and is located at DS 5225. Its target is suspected to be the Vinh Son area.

b. Unidentified Company/47th BN: The infantry element is located at DS 5112 with a strength of 60 men. They are equipped with 12mm mortars and small arms.

c. 406th Sapper BN: This unit is located at DS 4302 and has an estimated strength of 400. It is located a great distance from our worksite but can be connected to cause trouble.

Also because of the low strength of most of the enemy units you can expect ambushes and snippings of smaller elements of your units. Therefore it is imperative that you have sufficient security at all times. This would also include security of R&P sites during the day.

Many of the units in our AO are at the present time undergoing training collecting food and attempting to consolidate personnel. Almost all units are under strength and are low on food. Some units are even so low on food that they have had to use part of their element as food production teams and still others have had to disband and told to live off the economy as there has been insufficient food to feed the larger units.

Because of the shortage of personnel and food the Red Guards are continuing to show up at many military installations. Also because of the personnel and food problems the enemy units are unable to stage big attacks so it is felt that the number of minings, sniping, and ambushes will increase in 1971. This will probably be your main problem area during the 1971 Constriction season.
