 - a. Announcement and discussion of tentative millage rate of 5.5600 per \$1,000 of taxable value and the percent of increase (8.39%) over the tolled-back rate (5.1294). The increase over last year's actual millage rate (0.00%).
 - b. Presentation of tentative Budget for FY 2021-2022 – Vice Mayor Block stated no presentation is needed as this is the fourth meeting on the Budget.
 - c. Public Comments – None
 - d. Vote: Adoption of Resolution No. 2021-13 of the Town Commission of the Town of Jupiter Inlet Colony, Florida, establishing and levying the final millage rate of 5.5600 mills per \$1,000 of taxable value for the Town of Jupiter Inlet Colony, Florida ensuing Fiscal Year 2021/2022.
