 Johnny, Rosemary, and Mark opened the KACB bank account and are the signors on the account. We were issued temporary checks, debit cards, and have mobile banking capabilities. The account was opened with \$400.00 from donations

- Discussion on where to store the KACB archive paperwork and supplies was discussed. We will
 check into a storage unit to rent. Until then, nelida has the cleanup supplies and dianna is storing

- We now have a PO box. Our address is PO Box 1523 Fulton, Texas 78358. The cost of \$30.00 per year is our first expenditure.

 are part time and a convenient way to recycle has to be implemented to make it easier for everyone. Getting
